

LETTER OF INTENT

2018 Community Youth Fellowships

The letter of intent (LOI) must be no more than two pages (single-spaced). Applicants should be sure to provide answers to each of the questions below. The LOI can be submitted instead as a video or sound recording (maximum 4 minutes).

Supplemental materials cannot be submitted via the online application system, but applicants are welcome to include links to relevant information in their letter or resume/bio that may help us better understand the proposed project or the person who will be taking it on.

- 1. What is the title of your project?
- 2. What is the challenge you would like to solve with your project?
- 3. Why are you the right person to take on this work? Tell us about your story.
- 4. Who is your constituency? Be as specific as possible about whom you hope to work with to solve the challenge above.
- 5. How is your constituency experiencing the challenge on which your project is based?
- 6. What would the community look like if the challenge was solved? What is the change you want to see?
- 7. Why is your project needed and important?
