In 1989, David Tiser was four years old.

DAVID TISER:

Like a majority of the LGBT community, they did a huge step these 30 years. They can be open, gay or lesbian. We have registered partnerships, now we speak about marriage. Seventy or eighty percent of the Czech society, they support LGBT people, so it's different and better.

Ten years ago, when I put on Facebook that it's okay to be gay, then Roma would write me only bad things. Now, when I put on Facebook that it's okay to be gay, there will be four or five people who will write me bad things, and hundreds and hundreds of people, Roma people, who will support. And this is the difference.
